Who is the course for?

Assessment Methods

At the end of the course there is a 30-minute examination consisting of multiple-choice questions. An official IOSH certificate is awarded upon completion.

Course Syllabus

- **Module 1: Thinking Back** refreshes core health and safety principles, including manager responsibilities, key terminology, and the importance of managing safely, alongside the purpose of an effective safety and health management system.
- **Module 2: Leadership** explores how effective leadership drives strong safety performance and influences workplace culture, highlighting the principles that support positive safety management.
- **Module 3: Plan** covers the role of planning, policies, legal requirements, and performance indicators within a safety and health management system, and where to find practical guidance.
- **Module 4: Do** focuses on putting safety controls into practice through risk assessment, hazard identification, and risk reduction using the hierarchy of control.
- **Module 5: Check** examines how safety performance is monitored through indicators, audits, and incident investigations, and the value of proactive and reactive measures.
- **Module 6: Act** Looks at reviewing performance, taking corrective action, and driving continual improvement in safety and health management.
